



## what is our place peel?

Our Place Peel provides residential and support services for homeless and at-risk youth in Peel Region through four programs. Each year Our Place Peel helps over 550 youth in crisis.

### emergency youth shelter

- Peel Region's only emergency youth shelter, located in Mississauga, with 14 beds for youth aged 16 to 21.
- Youth in crisis receive safe shelter and food, counselling, support, and referrals.
- Youth stay in this program for three weeks, on average.
- Staffed 24 hours per day.
- Staff helps youth develop and attain realistic goals which may include family reconciliation, if feasible.
- If home is not a viable option, staff assists youth learn the skills they need to survive.

### resource room

- Located in Mississauga, in the emergency youth shelter.
- Open to any youth in the community aged 16 to 21.
- Provides computer / Internet access, and one-on-one support and group workshops to assist with employment and accommodation searches.

### funding

- Our Place Peel is a registered, non-profit charity. Funding is provided by the Province of Ontario, the Region of Peel, the United Way of Peel Region, fundraising events, and donations from service clubs, schools, faith groups, corporations, foundations and concerned individuals.
